A judging panel will select the photo that they feel best illustrates and captures the spirit of community and volunteerism in each section.

Winners of the Open and Junior Sections (15 years & under) both receive \$50 cash prize plus an hour workshop with Graham Spring

THE WRECK OF THE S.S. ADMELLA

The wreck of the SS Admella in the early hours of August 6th 1859 was only the beginning of a horrific week for survivors who remained on board, in sight of land, while authorities & volunteers struggled to rescue them from the stricken steamer. The loss of 89 lives, mostly due to dehydration, cold and exposure makes the wreck one of the worst maritime disasters in Australian history.

The 150th Anniversary of the tragedy will be commemorated, and the bravery, heroism and selflessness of those involved in the rescue celebrated during the:

Judges Choice: (Open Section & Junior Section – 15 years and under) A representative of Interwork Ltd, Graham Spring from Spring Studio and an Admella Commemoration Advisory Committee representative will judge the photo that best illustrates & captures the volunteer and community spirit within South Australia's Limestone Coast and Victoria's Discovery Coast.

1. Photographs must be 5" x 7" in size, mounted on card or paper in preparation for hanging.
2. The **bottom front** of the mounting card or paper **must** include typed (12 Arial font) Title and if you wish an interpretation/description of the photo may also be included. (max 30 words).
3. The **back** of the mounting card or paper **must** include the location taken, photographer's name, section entered, postal address, phone number and the nominated community group and contact details for presentation of possible prize money.
4. 'Nominated Community Group' for the purpose of this competition is a not-for-profit community organisation within South Australia's Limestone Coast & Victoria's Discovery Coast, not an individual.
5. The workshop date & time for each winning photographer is to be arranged with Graham Spring from Spring Studio by each winner and to be conducted before 31/12/09.
6. By entering, participants warrant that their entry materials are original and he or she owns the copyright to the photo, do not infringe on any third party's rights, and has obtained any necessary permissions from any third party if a third party or third party's property appears in the photograph.
7. The organisers of the aforementioned photographic competition are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, or any technical or human error that may occur in the processing of submissions for this competition, including but not limited to any misprints or typographical errors. The same organisers assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries.

Your entry to the contest constitutes your agreement to allow your photographs and your name to be published as finalists and selected award winners in any media releases, promotion, publications or websites used by the District Council of Grant Admella Commemoration Advisory Committee, organisers and Interwork Limited. Photographers will be credited. Entrants retain ownership and all other rights to future use of their photographs.

8. People Choice Award voting on the official voting slip only at the cost \$1.00 per slip is counted as one vote.
9. If, for any reason, this competition is not capable of completion as planned for any reasons, The Admella Committee and the organisers of the photographic competition reserves the right at their sole discretion to cancel, modify or suspend this competition.
10. All photographs must be taken in the SA Limestone Coast or Victorian Discovery Coast regions.
11. Entry is free of charge with a limit of three entries per person. No photo may be entered in more than one section. Space limitation for displays may result in a minimum of one entry being exhibited and no late entries accepted.
12. All decisions by the judges will be final and binding. No correspondence or discussions into their decisions shall be made or entered into.
13. Prints of photographs submitted may not be returned to entrants and a violation of any of the foregoing rules may disqualify the photo entry.
